On August 6, 2012, Dick entered the presence of the Lord he loved and served. He was born in Steubenville, Ohio, and graduated from Asbury University in Wilmore, Kentucky with a B.A. in voice in 1955. In 1961 he earned a M.Div. degree from Emory University, Candler School of Theology, with further study at Columbia University, NY City.

Prior to coming to Sarasota he served for 6 years as alumni and recruitment director of Stillman College in Tuscaloosa, Alabama, and participated in the civil rights movement during that time. He has been a resident of Sarasota since 1967, and through most of that time served as a Realtor, most recently with Michael Saunders & Co. This is the community he loved and the company he respected. For many years he was actively involved with the Gideons.

The highlights of Dick's life were the relationships and friendships with those around him and the connections he made, and foremost was his love for Jesus.

He is survived by Mary, his wife of 57 years; his daughter, Helen Renee Lewis; his son, Richard W. Lewis and his wife Lisa; and his God-son Kevin Randall and his wife Jenna. He leaves 11 grandchildren, and 14 great grandchildren, with whom he played with joy when he had the chance!

Dick's memorial service will be at 11:00 AM Saturday 8/11, in the Life Center of the Church of Hope, where he worshiped, 1560 Wendell Kent Road, parallel to I-75 between University Parkway and Fruitville Road.
