Robert "Bob" David Conk, 86, of Inverness, FL, went to be with his Lord and Savior on his birthday, November 11, 2009. Bob was born on a weekend trip to Carbondale, PA on November 11, 1923 when home was Binghamton, New York. He loved Buffalo and always called it home. He also loved calling square dances and golf. He was a physical education teacher, a school principal and a veteran of World War II and the Korean Conflict. He was very proud of his service to his country as a Chief Radio Man in the U.S. Navy. He graduated from the University of Buffalo with the nickname "The Toe" as the football teams kicker and during his career in education became a football and wrestling coach. He was preceded in death by his wife, Barbara McComb-Conk, November 23, 2006. He is survived by his ex-wife of 30 years, Elizabeth McCarthy-Conk and five children: Kathleen Hubbard of Derby, NY; Nancy Leone of Sarasota, FL; Mary Piwowarczyk of Hamburg, NY; Peggy Hamilton of Lehigh Acres, FL; and Robert Joseph Conk of Denver, CO; as well as 9 grandchildren and 7 great grandchildren.
