Robert Louis Stevenson, 76, of Fort Myers, Florida passed away November 9, 2011 with his loving family by his side.

He was born February 23, 1935 in Rochester, New York the son of George and Mary (Curran) Stevenson.

Robert was a graduate of the General Motors Institute earning a Bachelor's Degree. That was one of many accomplishments attained during his service to GM where his responsibilities ranged from personnel to plant manager. His work also took him from locations around Rochester all the way to Beijing during his 37 year career. After leaving the auto industry and relocating to Florida, Robert continued to work and, before retiring another two times, was known to enjoy the game of golf.
