During WWII he was a staff Sargent in the Army Air Corps and served in Normandy and North & South France from January 25, 1942 to October 27, 1945. He bravely flew in B-17 planes, placing himself in danger to protect our freedoms. After the service he went on to become an attorney and later worked at Western Electric in Chicago. He received many awards and plaques from them during his forty-three year career.

Robert is survived by his wife, Eloisa Susal and her three children, whom fondly referred to him as "Papa Bear." He was a great role model, doting husband, amazing dad, coach, mentor, soldier, and friend to many. The family is so very thankful for the time they had together and move forward in the comfort of all the special memories they have of him. They only wish he was here to continue making memories with them. He was the heart of the family.

Robert Susal will be laid to rest at Sarasota National Cemetery. The service will begin at 3:30pm on Friday, September 25, 2020. The Military Air Corps will play taps and present the American flag to the family. The Army will then

perform a 21 gun salute. These military honors will be followed by a eulogy and blessing officiated by Saint Patrick's Church. Bagpipes will play before and after the service. He leaves us with the same honor and grace that he brought to this world.
