



Roger William Pariseau Jr

Roger William Pariseau, Jr. died in Lehigh Acres, Florida on July 5, 2019. He had been a resident of the Fort Myers area since 1996. He was 83.

Roger was born in Pawtucket, Rhode Island in 1936, the son of the late Roger and Flora (Charpentier) Pariseau and spent his formative years with his late brother Donald and sisters Nancy (Noonan) and the late Louise (Souza) growing up in Seekonk, Massachusetts. With his brother Donald, he started the Tower Hill Dairy Farm while still in his teens. He worked many jobs in his lifetime, at Chemical Products Corporation, Texas Instruments, Hendricks Pools and as a salesman with both DeBlois and Dupuis Heating Oil Companies. He served in the US Naval Reserve but was activated from 1961 to 1962 during the Cuban Missile Crisis, being honorably discharged from his service in the gunnery on the USS Parle. He was an active athlete, playing basketball, golf, and softball for most of his life. In Florida, he worked in advertising sales for a Yellow Pages company and became a member of the Moose Lodge in the Lehigh Acres area.

He was married in 1960 to Sylvia (Janes) with whom he had one son, Kevin. They were divorced in 1989. In addition to his son, he leaves a daughter-in-law Pamela and grandson Nicolas, all of Nyack, New York.

Roger will be interred at the Rhode Island Veterans Memorial Cemetery in

Exeter, Rhode Island.
