Ronald Earl Guffey, went to Heaven on May 16th, 2020. Ron was born on January 24th, 1956, at Grandma Guffey's house in New Harmony, Indiana. He is one of six children born to Oliver & Helen (Cato) Guffey. Ron graduated from New Harmony High School in New Harmony, Indiana in 1974. He enlisted in the United States Army several months after graduating high school. In the 4 years he served he became a paratrooper in the "101st Airborne. Completed one tour in Vietnam and achieved the rank of E-5 (Sergeant). After serving in the Country, Ron went to work for General Oilfield Equipment, transporting oil field equipment across the Country, for 10 years. He worked for Joe Corn, hauling coast to coast. Ron moved to Florida in 1988 and worked with his brother Jim's Concrete. He started "Guff's Lawn Care", closed the business last year, due to his health.

Ron loved anything mixed with History and Military. Some of his Greatest Adventures came from fishing either Lake Okeechobee and his favorite fishing holes in the Gulf.

Ron is survived by his wife Dorinia, 2 sons and 2 daughters, Joshua Guffey, Nicholas (Reina) Guffey, Alicia Guffey, Alexandria Guffey, and 3 grandchildren, Adlee, Amelia, Beau Reed.
