Sally Davis, 58, died unexpectedly Thursday, July 19 at her home in Cape Coral, FL. She was born on January 22, 1954 at Great Lakes Naval Hospital, Michigan to John and Irma (Korte) Davis, who preceded her in death. Sally was the fourth and last child born in her family. She was the "baby" which was often to her advantage. Because they were an Army military family, Sally grew up in various locations in the States and Stuttgart, Germany. Sally graduated from Savannah High School, Georgia in 1972. She went on to get an Associate of Arts Degree, Young Harris College, Georgia, 1974; Bachelor of Arts Degree, LaGrange College, Georgia, 1976; and, Master of Arts Degree, Scarritt College, Nashville, Tennessee, 1978. Sally's early career was as Director of Christian Education for United Methodist churches in Garden City, Kansas; Valley Center, Kansas; and Jacksonville, Florida. She began working for Goodwill Industries of Southwest Florida in 1985 recently celebrating 27 years with them as a Senior Vocational Evaluator/ Work Adjustment Specialist. She was a member of the National Rehabilitation Assn, Florida Rehabilitation Assn and Christ United Methodist Church in Lehigh Acres. She had a great sense of humor and lighthearted outlook on life. Sally enjoyed going to outdoor jazz festivals as well as attending baseball games. She always found the good in people and was "in her element" when helping the disadvantaged. Joyful is a term her family always uses when describing her. She lived her faith, carrying it with her everywhere she went. She was very close with her friends, even keeping in touch with elementary, high school and

college friends. Her family was extremely close to her - her death leaves an indescribable hole in their lives. Her sisters survive her: Marilyn Bentz of Lehigh Acres, FL and Nancy Plews of Shelton, WA. Also surviving is a nephew, John Pope of Cape Coral, FL and a niece, Lori Johnson of Shelton, WA. Her brother, Bill, preceded her in death just this past February. A viewing is planned for Friday, August 3 from 6-8 pm at Anderson-Patterson Funeral Home, 2701 Lee Blvd, Lehigh Acres. Memorial Services are on Saturday, August 4 at 4 pm at Christ United Methodist Church. There will be a light supper served following the service.
