Tammy Gehlhausen, 56, passed away on her birthday on Wednesday, January 10, 2024. She passed peacefully at Lehigh Regional Medical Center. She was born on January 10, 1968, in Hershey Pennsylvania to the late Connie Krimm.

Tammy had a varied working career, including service as the catering manager in the Officer's Club at Fort Wainwright, Alaska, 120 miles south of the Arctic Circle. For the last 19 years she was a teacher at seven different schools in both Lee and Hendry Counties, at the elementary, middle, and high school levels. Although she also taught physical education, math, and GED preparation, her true love rested with her kids in the exceptional student education program. She was named a Lee County Teacher of Distinction multiple times and was named the VFW District 13 elementary school teacher of the year.

Tammy initially enrolled in college with an athletic scholarship to play soccer, and her love of sports followed her through her adult life. She tried to run at least one 5K race a month, and she coached both boys and girls at the middle school and high school levels in multiple sports. In addition to running, she owned dogs and guinea pigs, painted on canvas, worked on crafts, and volunteered in the Auxiliary of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States.

Tammy was a selfless and loving wife, mother, grandmother, and friend. She never met a person in need that she did not try to help. She was preceded in

death by her mother and her brother, Dale Babcock. She is survived by a loving and devoted family, including her husband Mike, her sons Blake T. Bayly (wife, Shea). and Cameron Bayly (wife, Marissa), sister Kim Nobles, five grandchildren Benjamin, Blake, Madilynn, and the twins that are waiting to be born, in addition to numerous nieces and nephews.
