



Terrence Wynn Bartlett

February 11, 1941 - May 18, 2024

Terrence "Pat" Wynn Bartlett, 83, of Sarasota, Florida (formerly Albany, NY and Parkersburg, WV) sadly left us on May 18, 2024 after a long illness.

He was born on February 11, 1941 to Clyde and Mary Bartlett in Parkersburg, WV. Pat graduated from Parkersburg High School in 1959. Pat was an amazing high school athlete. He played on a state championship basketball team, he also played baseball and was a signature away from being drafted by the New York Yankees. He went on to study Sociology and Philosophy at West Virginia State College. Pat was one of the first African American children to attend Parkersburg High School as a result of Brown v. Board of Education.

After graduating with a Master's degree in Sociology, from Case Western Reserve, in Cleveland, Ohio, he started his first job at the NYS Office Family and Children Services in Albany, NY as a Program Executive Administrator, kickstarting a 30 year career. During this 30 tenure, he was appointed to be the Commissioner's Chief of Staff.

In 1962, Pat met Eleanor at West Virginia State College. Pat and Eleanor went on to have 2 children, Terri Bowes and Kevin Bartlett. He also leaves behind his four grandchildren: Taryn Cade-Saez, Tselan Cade, Arianna Bartlett, Isabel Bartlett, and his beloved great grandchild, Nazari Saez, aka 'The Great'. They cherished 60 years of marriage together.

In 1996, Pat retired and spent his time starting a second career which was helping to raise his two oldest grandchildren, Taryn and Tselan. They have fond memories of spending time with him during their most impressionable years.

Pat was predeceased by his parents and his brothers, Jeffrey, Meredith, and David Bartlett. He is survived by his sister Gay Nash and his brother Keith Bartlett. Pat was adored by his family and he loved spending time with them.
