Thomas Martin Nebus, aka Tommy, died unexpectedly in Nokomis, Florida in May, 2018, at the age of 66. He is preceded in death by his mother, Emily Nebus, his father, Martin Nebus and his brother, Timothy Nebus.

Tommy was born on January 14, 1952 and attended Naples High School. He was drafted into the Armed Services after high school and served in the Viet Nam War. As an M16 Gunner and heavy equipment operator, his assignments included shooting the enemy from helicopters and clearing fields for runways and military operations.

After an Honorable Discharge, Tommy moved back to his home state of Florida where he was an accomplished worker in the building trade. Years ago he worked on many South Florida projects including at the time the building of many structures on what was the new development of Marco Island, Florida. He resided in several Florida cities in his lifetime. Towards the end of his life, he was living in Nokomis, FL near Sarasota, FL and fishing everyday. Fishing being one of his passions, he telephoned his friends daily to give them his fishing report

He was also active as an American Vet and belonged to the American Legion.

To know Tommy was to love him and his unique ways. He always marched to

the beat of a different drummer. Anyone who knew him also knew that he was a kind and generous man.

He leaves behind several cousins and many friends.

A military service honoring Tommy will be held at the Naples Memorial Gardens in North Naples, Florida, Thursday, December 13 at 3:00 at the gravesite. He will be interred along with his Mother, Father and Brother.
