Todd R. Myers, age 64, of Sarasota, Florida passed away on December 22, 2025 at Sarasota Memorial Hospital.

Born on April 3, 1961, in Kokomo, Indiana to parents Robert Gene and Mary Ellen (Isler) Myers. The family moved to Warren, Michigan in 1965. Todd graduated from Cousino High School in 1979 and subsequently moved to Sarasota, Florida in 1983. He became a member of the Fraternal Order of Eagles 2756 in 1985 and shortly thereafter became their bartender. As a 40-year member of the Eagles, Todd was President of the Aerie six times, Mr. Eagle, and Valentine's King among his other achievements.
