Todd Eugene Wickmann, age 46, passed away on March 12, 2015. He was born on August 5, 1968 in Edina, Minnesota, to Roger and Peggy (Blair) Wickmann. Todd attended Orchard Lake Elementary in Lakeville, Minn., and Bethany Academy in Bloomington, MN., graduating in 1987. He went to college at Anderson University in Anderson, Indiana, graduating with an athletic trainer degree in 1991. Todd did post grad at Bemidji State University. That year Todd also coached girls basketball, as well as being a referee. The fall of 1992 Todd began Chiropractic College at Northwestern College of Chiropractic in Bloomington, Minn. He graduated with his doctorate in November of 1995. While waiting to take his state boards, Todd returned to Bemidji State University where he was a professor and also put together their Sports Management Curriculum, as well as managing the Rec Center. Todd then bought a practice in Bemidji, and called it, CHIROPRACTIC SPORT AND SPINAL REHAB and continued practicing in Bemidji until late fall of 2005 when he and his wife Katia moved to Fort Myers, Florida. The fall of 2006 Todd opened a new practice, LIFE STYLES CHIROPRACTIC, which he continued to work through his illness. Todd also did an internship the summers of 1988, 1989, 1990 and 1991 as Athletic Trainer with the Minnesota Vikings during their Summer training in Mankato, Minnesota under Dr. Fred Zamberletti. Todd married Katia August 4, 2000, on the shores of Kabekona Lake, Laporte, Minn. They had a vow renewal ceremony in Costa Rica on December 2000. Together they have been blessed with two special children,

Abigail Hope, age 9, and Nathan Ross, age 7. Todd is survived by his parents, Roger and Peggy, one brother, Tweit (wife, Jolynn) and two sisters, Tonia (Stan) Harder and Tiffany (Kristian) Alekov. Todd has 7 nieces and 6 nephews, Father and mother-in-law (Roldolfo and Emilia) and Grandma Blair. He also has several uncles and aunts. He was preceded in death by his Grandma Wickmann, Grandpa Wickmann, and Grandpa Blair.
