Walter Joseph Postula, Esq., died peacefully at home in Fort Myers, FL on July 2, 2018. He was born on June 8, 1947, in Detroit, MI to Walter and Hedwig Postula. His educational history included a bachelor's degree from Marquette University and a law degree from the University of Miami. He worked for the Department of Justice for 13 years, rising to become the head of the U.S. Attorney Office in Orlando, and later an attorney in private practice. During retirement, he devoted his time to pro bono legal cases, volunteering with Meals on Wheels, and enjoyed modernizing old Florida homes. We loved him for his generous heart and sense of humor; we will all miss him greatly.
