William Kenneth Henderson, 63, died May 25, 2011 with his family by his side in Fort Myers, Florida. He was born October 30, 1947 in St. Louis, Missouri to William Lewis and Shirley Jean Steimann. His only son Kenneth Scott Henderson was born in December of 1971. In February of 2007 he married his wife Sandy Ann Moore Henderson. Ken graduated from Crawford High School in 1965. He attended Mesa College and graduated from San Diego State, majoring in Business Administration with a minor in Electrical Engineering. Ken proudly served in the U.S. Army. After his discharge he was employed by San Diego Gas and Electric as an Electrical Engineer. When he moved to Jacksonville, Florida, he worked for Jacksonville Electric Authority as an Electrical Engineer, owned his own landscaping business, and then worked for Bove Construction as a superintendent at several construction sites, the last being in Punta Gorda and his latest adventure at Florida Gulf Coast University as a Safety Inspector part time. His interests included family, horsing around, ballroom dancing, building things, and working. He devoted most of his time and energy to his family and the care of animals. He loved cats and worked with the cat rescue shelter in Jacksonville. His other passion was baseball, after playing in high school and college, he went on to coach little league and recently was umpiring. He will be remembered for his big smile, quick to laugh at himself, or tell a funny story or two. He was a best friend to so many of the people he touched. His soft voice and listening ear were always present. Ken is survived by his wife Sandy Henderson of Fort

Myers; Son, Scott and daughter-in-law Micah Henderson of Jacksonville; 3 grandchildren Elizabeth, William and Emma, step children Kristie Lane Moore of Fort Myers, and Jerry Lee Moore III of Atlanta, parents William and Jodi Henderson of Big Bear, California; siblings, Bonnie and Dave Larson of San Diego; Ronnie and Bob Henderson of San Diego; and Debbie Braasch of St. Louis, Missouri.
