Bill was an avid outdoors man; whether it was slaying dolphin in the Keys, hunting gators in the Kissimmee river (in the notorious gator boat that may or may not have been taking on water), or chasing that monster buck with his sons, his zest for life was second to none.

Bill had an uncanny ambition that may have been sponsored by 5 hour energy. Throughout his career, he didn't just show up; he set the bar on how to be a leader and mentor. 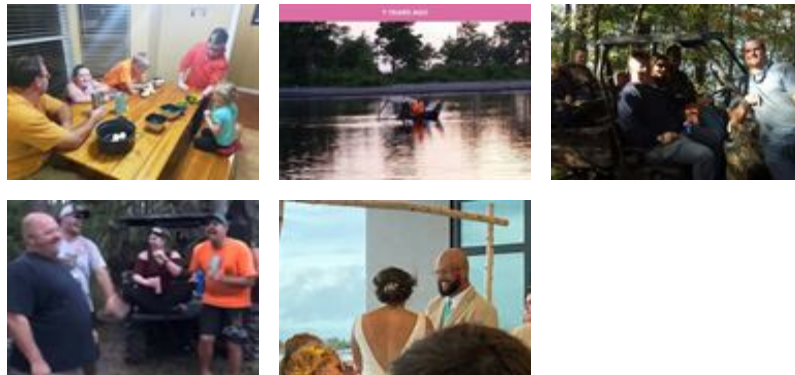

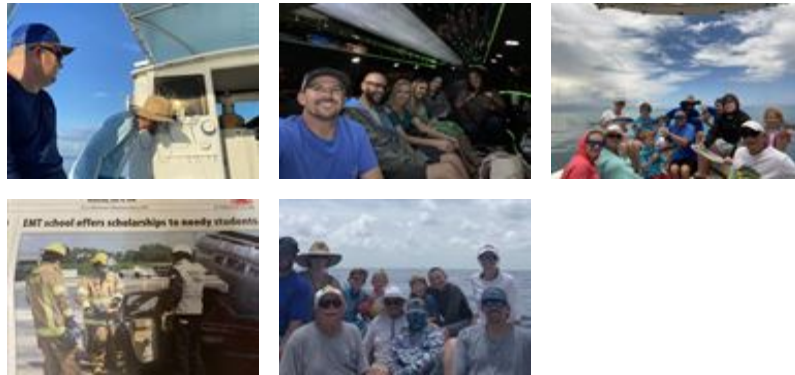
