William Sager, 97, formerly of Bay City Michigan, and a resident of Sarasota for many years went to be with the Lord on May 30, 2019. He was an alumnus of Michigan State University and the University of California-Berkley. He fought in World War II, serving in General Patton's 3rd Armored Division as a tank commander and was wounded at Bastogne during the Battle of the Bulge. He was awarded several service medals including the Purple Heart and three Bronze Stars. Following the war, he worked as a chemist for the Dow Chemical Company and received two patents for his research work. He was active in many volunteer activities including youth work, Scoutmaster in Boy Scouts, the Lions Club, and positions within Baptist churches serving as Trustee, greeter and usher. Bill and his wife, Elaine, were avid world travelers. He is survived by four children – David (Marilyn), Mark (Mary), Scott (Sue), and Barbara Gjeldum (Dan); nine grandchildren – David Mark, Chandra, Kari, Joshua, Justin, John, Lindsay, Tyler and Sara; and six great grandchildren – Evan, Riley, Henry, Will, Kellan, Elliot and Nora. A memorial service will be held on Wednesday, June 5 at 11:00am at the First Baptist Church of Sarasota chapel.
